Who is Everett Bowman? Everett Bowman (July 12, 1899 – October 25, 1971) was an American rodeo cowboy who competed from the 1920s to 1940s. Bowman became a candidate for the sheriff's office in Maricopa County as a Democrat in 1944, and gained a job as sheriff in Wickenburg. Bowman died at the age of 72 while flying a plane he owned, which crashed near the ranch he tended. Bowman was inducted into the ProRodeo Hall of Fame in 1979.

Non-Stock: Engine change - modified parts and/or body - custom paint/decals - custom chrome or upholstery

Mild: Modified parts and/or body - upgraded roll cage - up to 3" lift - upgraded wheels/tires

Wild: Heavy roll cage - cut fenders - up to 5" lift - upgraded wheels/tires - modified suspension, parts and/or body

Extreme: heavily modified suspension, parts and/or body - more than 5" lift

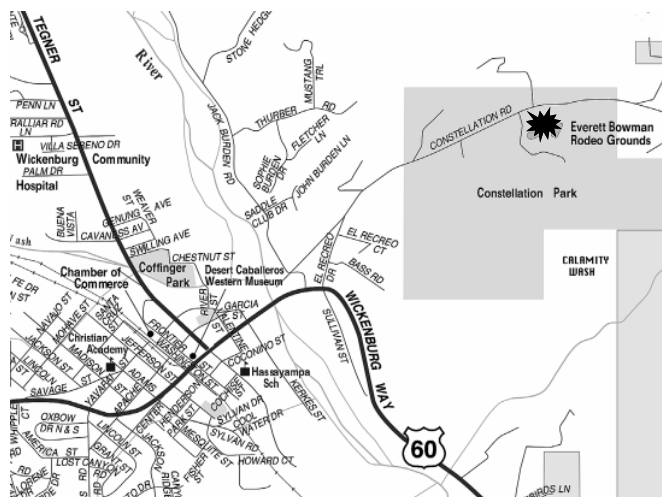
